

And as long as companies perpetuate those attitudes, it's going to be tough for women to join the ranks of tech. That's why Facebook is going to ramp up its efforts to recruit and retain women — while also creating and cultivating an inclusive culture that will allow for more women to succeed. It's one of the most ambitious plans of any tech company. In fact, it's setting a new standard for how to make it easier for women to succeed. The first step is training. In the next six months, Facebook plans to send more than 15,000 employees through training focused on diversity and inclusion, much more than any other company, Facebook says.
